

**DRIVE CLEAN APPLICATION FORM:
Hot Rod Vehicle**

The purpose of this form is to apply for a Hot Rod emissions inspection.

A hot rod is a vehicle in which the original motor has been replaced with a motor of a type not available by the manufacturer on that model of motor vehicle. 'Type' refers to either the manufacturer or the block size of the replacement engine. If your application is approved, your vehicle will receive a less stringent emissions inspection than normally applied to a vehicle of the same model year, weight and fuel type.

Vehicles eligible to apply for a hot rod emissions inspection are:

- Gasoline light-duty vehicles of model year **1999** and older; or
- Diesel light-duty vehicles of model year **1998 or 1999**.

Receiving approval for a hot rod emissions inspection does not exempt a vehicle from on-road enforcement of emissions control equipment under Ontario Regulation 361/98.

To apply for a hot rod emissions inspection, please provide all of the following supporting documentation:

- Labour/parts receipts or work orders showing that the original motor has been replaced with a motor of a type or block size not installed by the manufacturer on that model year of motor vehicle and the date of the modifications
- One photo* of the entire engine compartment showing the replacement engine
- One photo* of the engine from further back than the one above that clearly shows it part of the car indicated.
- One photo* of the rear of the vehicle that includes identifiers such as make, model, and licence plate
- One photo* of the vehicle's VIN plate or door sticker
- Note:** If it is not possible for the Drive Clean Office to confirm the displacement of the replacement engine using the above information, it is the responsibility of the vehicle owner to provide supporting documentation which satisfies the Drive Clean Office and may include documentation from the vehicle manufacturer.

*All photos must clearly show the details required above. Multiple photos of the engine will be accepted.
